Wednesday, May 22nd. About 9 or 11 of Man of Honor people along with members of American Legion Post 10, VFW 388, including a handful of women who are part of the Wausau area Daughters of the American Revolution. Met at Pine Grove Cemetery to raise awareness and to Honor a veteran who lies in a unmarked grave in the back of the cemetery known as Potter's Field. The term Potter's Field is a name of an area of a cemetery used for the burials of unknown. This man fought in WW1 and he later died by suicide in the late fall of 1930 alone. The unknown soldier was buried by Post 388 VFW and Post 10 American Legion.


